

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY POLICY STATEMENT

Skipton Walking Football Club is committed to promote a safe and healthy working environment for all attendees. Skipton WFC will take all reasonable steps to inspire a safe and social sporting activity that ensures walking football will be played safely with full consideration of every participants' age, gender, and ability.

This policy sets out our arrangements for ensuring we meet our health and safety obligations whilst playing walking football.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Skipton WFC recognises that safety is the responsibility of everyone within the Club.

The founder Mr Christopher McGrath will act as a point of contact for advice on health and safety and will ensure that this policy is implemented, published and accessible to all participants.

Participants must :

- Understand and follow the health and safety arrangements and rules.
- Take reasonable care for their own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what they do or not do

INFORMATION

Skipton WFC will comply with its legal duties for health and safety and provide participants with information and instruction.

ARRANGEMENTS

To achieve the aims set in this statement, Skipton WFC will:

- Ensure all sessions and tournaments are risk assessed prior to the session taking place.
- Create a safe environment by putting health and safety measures in place as identified by the assessment before the session / tournament takes place.
- Provide COVID-19 Guidance on returning to play.
- Promote a positive safe culture at the club.
- Promote accident and injury prevention.

This Policy Statement will be reviewed annually taking into account any legislation changes, government guidance, lessons learned and best practice.
